1. From and after the commencement of this Order the provisions of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908 shall apply to the Scheduled Area described in the Schedule hereto. Provided that the provisions of that Order relating to an Infected Area shall not apply to any part of the Scheduled Area, unless such part is for the time being declared by Order of the Board to be, or form part of, a Swine-Fever Infected Area.

Revocation of Existing Regulations.

2. Any regulation made by a Local Authority of a District comprised in the Scheduled Area as to movement into or within their District which is in force at the commencement of this Order is hereby revoked as from that date.

Saving of Local Order.

3. This Order shall not affect the provisions of the Mitcham and District (Swine-Fever) Order of 1908.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and eight.
