Collation, Institution, Induction, Licence to Perpetual Curacy.

The fees to be taken in respect of Collation and Induction, or Institution and Induction to a benefice with Cure of Souls and for a Licence to a Perpetual Curacy shall be in accordance with and be regulated by the following Scale:—

“Annual Value” means the Net Annual Value of the benefice as defined by the Pluralities Acts (1 and 2 Vict., cap. 106 and 13 and 14 Vict., cap. 93) and will in case of difference be certified by the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England (*vide* Rule 2).

“Secretary” means Secretary of Archbishop or Bishop.
