Other Fees of Apparitor, Sealer, and Record Keeper.

The following fees may continue to be taken by any Apparitor, Sealer, or Record Keeper, who was appointed to his office before the 10th December, 1895, so long as he shall continue to discharge the duties of his office, but upon his death or resignation such fees shall wholly cease to be taken and shall not be claimed by or payable to the successor, if any, of such Apparitor, Sealer, or Record Keeper. These fees, where payable, are to be in addition to those hereinbefore prescribed, and payable to any Vicar-General, Chancellor, Registrar, or Secretary, respectively. Any demand or application for these Fees shall be in writing and shall state the name and address of the Apparitor, Sealer, or Record Keeper, claiming the fee and the date of his appointment.
