


## Peterhead—Alteration in Harbours.

Particulars.—The reproduction of portions of Chart No. 1438, given below, show the alterations which have been made in the depths by dredging, the reconstruction of the piers, and the positions of lights in Peterhead Harbours.

Position.-Southern entrance red light; lat. 57° 30' N., long. 1° 464' W.





Caution.—The greatest caution must be exercised in passing the submerged position of Birnie's Pier.

## Herthu Flat-Intended Buoy.

Particulars — During July, 1908, a buoy of the undermentioned description will be established on the shoal head recently found near the Hertha Flat in the Kattegat.

Position of shoal head.—At a distance of about  $9\frac{1}{2}$  miles S. 47° E. from the Skaw Lighthouse; lat. 57°  $38\frac{3}{4}$ ' N., long. 10°  $53\frac{1}{4}$ ' E., on Chart No. 2114.

Description.—A conical buoy painted is red and white vertical stripes.

Variation.-10° W.
