TENDERS FOR LOANS ON TREASURY BILLS.

1. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's
Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be
received at the Chief Cashier's Office, at the Bank
of England, on Monday, the 6th July, at one
o'clock, for Treasury Bills to be issued under
the Acts 40 Vic., cap. 2, 52 Vic., cap. 6,
to the amount of £2,500,000 in replacement of
Bills falling due on the 11th July.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £1,000,
£5,000, or £10,000. They will be dated the
11th July, 1908, and will be payable at six
months after date, viz.:—on the 11th January,
1909.

3. *The Tenders must specify the net amount per
cent. which will be given for the amounts applied
for, and the Tenders of private individuals must be
made through a London Banker.*

4. The Bills will be issued and paid at the
Bank of England.

5. The persons whose Tenders are accepted
will be informed of the same on Tuesday, the
7th July, and payment in full of the amounts of
the accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank
of England not later than twelve o'clock, on
Saturday, the 11th July.

6. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's
Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any
Tenders.

WILD BIRD (ENGLAND).

The Wild Birds Protection (Administrative
County of Durham) Order, 1908.

Dated 25th June, 1908.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me
by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1904,
and upon application by the County Council of
the Administrative County of Durham, I hereby
make the following Order:—

Title.

I. This Order may be cited as "The Wild
Birds Protection (Administrative County of
Durham) Order, 1908."

BIRDS.

Close Time Extended.

II. The time during which the killing or taking
of Wild Birds is prohibited by the Act of 1880
shall be extended throughout the Administrative
County of Durham so as to be between the last
day of February and the 1st day of September in
any year.

Additions to the Schedule of the Act of 1880.

III. The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880,
shall apply within the Administrative County
of Durham to the following species of Wild
