

of June, in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, as an addition to the site of the parsonage or house of residence of the vicarage of Christ Church, Lower Nutfield, in the county of Surrey and in the diocese of Southwark, and in consideration also of a further benefaction of two hundred and sixteen pounds thirteen shillings and fourpence sterling which has been paid to us in favour of the same vicarage, and in respect of which we have agreed to pay to the Incumbent of the same vicarage, and to his successors, a yearly sum of six pounds and ten shillings, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Christ Church, Lower Nutfield, to meet the aforesaid benefactions, one capital sum of two hundred and fifty pounds, in respect of which, so long as the same capital sum, or any part thereof, shall remain in our hands, there shall be paid by us to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage one other yearly sum of seven pounds and ten shillings, or such part thereof as shall be proportionate to any balance of the same capital sum which shall so remain in our hands, the above-mentioned yearly payments to commence as from the fifteenth day of June, in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and on the first day of November in each and every year.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction consisting of a piece or parcel of land comprising two roods and thirty-three perches or thereabouts with the messuage and buildings thereon which has been permanently secured by deed dated the twenty-fourth day of June, in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, as an addition to the endowments of the vicarage of Elnton, in the county of Derby and in the diocese of Southwell, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Elnton, to meet such benefaction, one capital sum of seven hundred pounds, in respect of which, so long as the same capital sum, or any part thereof, shall remain in our hands, there shall be paid by us to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage one yearly sum of twenty-one pounds, or such part thereof as shall be proportionate to any balance of the same capital sum which shall so remain in our hands; the above-mentioned yearly payments to commence as from the twenty-fourth day of June, in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and on the first day of November in each and every year.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late

Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Llanynys, in the county of Denbigh and in the diocese of Saint Asaph, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, one yearly sum or stipend of thirty-five pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year: And we do also hereby grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Llanynys one capital sum of two hundred and fifty pounds sterling, to be applicable towards defraying the cost of purchasing certain land as additions to the parsonage house premises and the glebe of the said vicarage, such capital sum, or the balance thereof unapplied to such purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands at interest after the rate of two pounds and ten shillings per centum per annum: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient in our opinion to produce the said yearly sum or stipend of thirty-five pounds, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said vicarage, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Minister or Incumbent of the district and benefice of Saint Mary Magdalene, Millfield, in the county of Durham and in the diocese of Durham, and to his successors, Ministers or Incumbents of the same district and benefice, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and fifty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the twelfth day of May, in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that the said yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and fifty pounds hereby granted to the Minister or Incumbent for the time being of the said district and benefice of Saint Mary Magdalene, Millfield, shall be and be taken to be in lieu of and in substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and twenty pounds heretofore payable by us subject to certain conditions respecting the employment of two Assistant-Curates for the parish of Saint Luke, Pallion, in the said county of Durham, under the authority of an Instrument sealed by us on the twelfth day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and published in the London Gazette on the twentieth day of the same month and year; and provided also, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient in our opinion to produce the said yearly
