ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 14TH SEPTEMBER 1908.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Transfer of Area from one Scheduled Area to another.

1. From and after the commencement of this Order the Area described in the First Schedule hereto shall, for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908 and any modification of such Order which applies to the Scheduled Area described in the Second Schedule hereto, form part of that Area, and cease to form part of any other Scheduled Area.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-first day of September, nineteen hundred and eight.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Area Transferred.

The petty sessional division of Upper Chirk, the parish of Chirk, and that part of the parish

of Glyn Traian which lies to the south of the river Ceiriog, in the administrative county of Denbigh.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising the administrative county of Salop (except the parish of Brompton and Rhiston, and such parts of the parish of Chirbury as lie to the west of the River Camlad), and also comprising the petty sessional division of Overton, in the administrative county of Flint, and the parishes of Hyssington, Snead, Aston, Castlewright, Llangynog, Hirnant, Pennant, Llanrhaidr-yn-Mochnant, Llanfechain, Llansaintffraid Pool, Llansaintffraid Deythur, Careghofa, Llandrinio, Llandysilio, Criggion, and Bausley, and the borough of Llanfyllin, in the administrative county of Montgomery.

Fiæreflu and Röttingen Island—Beacons Established.

Subject.—Beacons have been established on Fiæreflu, Langenuen, and Röttingen Island, Björne Fiord, as undermentioned.

1. Fiæreflu Beacon.

Position.—On rock; lat. $59^{\circ} 52\frac{1}{2}'$ N., long. $5^{\circ} 33\frac{1}{2}'$ E.

Description.—Black stone beacon with black cylindrical topmark.

2. Röttingen Island Beacon.

Position.—On Sundötangen; lat. $60^{\circ} 8'$ N., long. $5^{\circ} 21\frac{3}{4}'$ E.

Description.—Black stone beacon.
