arch riet the E have an account from the Morea, That a Body of 6 or 7000 Turks came lately before Lepanto, where they opened Trenches, and made other Preparations to attack the Castle, expecting to be joined in few days by several Thousand Men more, which the Seraskier wasdrawing together for that design; The Garison all this while defended themselves very well; and on the 26th of this Month made a Sally, wherein they beat the Enemy out of their Trenches, killed 4 or 500 of them, and demolished their Works: The next day the Succour that was sent them by Sea entred into the place, which so disheartned the Enemy that they broke up and retired in disorder.

Novemb. 8. The Count de R.de-Rome , nac, the French Envoy, has had this Week Conferences with the Ministers **feveral** of this Court, upon the Propositions he made to the Pope at his last Audience; At the same time the Cardinals a' Estree and de Fourbin continue their Endeavours to adjust the Matters that remain yet undere mined about the French Bishops; They both had Audience of the Pope this Weck, and preffed him very carnefily to call a Confiftory in order to the Preconitation of those Bishops that still want their Bulls; and his faid they have obtained a promife that one shall be held for this purpose on Monday next The Pope continues in his Refolution of making divers Reforms for advancing the Splendor and The Chevalier Dignity of the See of Rome. Monaldi General of the Popes Gallies, arrived here this Week from Civita Vecchia, and has given him a particular Relation of their late Expedition in the Levant.

Milan, Novemb. 12. Our Governor Gene ral the Marquis de Leganes is come hither, after having taken a general Review of the Forces of this State near Novarre, who are now disperted into their Winter quarters. 'Tis said that his fixellency intends very suddenly to return to Turin to atilist at a great Council of War that will be held there to prepare things for an early Campagne the next year. The Republick of Ginnua has at last agreed to pay the Contributions demanded by the Germans for Winter-Quarters.

The Senate has refolved Venice, Novemb. 14. to chuse a new Captain General in the place of Signior Meccaigo, who is made Governor of Viz-cauza; but has not yet nam'd any Body for that Command. In the mean time they are taking care to reinforce their Army in the Levant, to which end they have not only given out Commisfinns this Week for raising two K giments of Dragoons, to condiff of 500 Men each, and making other new Levies in Italy, but are likewise treating with several Others to raise Troops in Gomany and Sufficiend for the Service of the Republick. By the last Letters from Dalmatia we have advice, That the Morlaques have lately made several Incursions into the Enemies Territories towardsTrelign es and Fopoca, wherethey plundered and burnt divers Villages, and took a confiderable Booty, which they brought to Caftel-News; And that the Turks to revenge this Ravage advanced with a firong Party towards Zarine, with a design to spoil and destroy the Country thereabouts, but were prevented by the Moriaques, who upon notice of their match, drew together, and attackt the Enemy fo fuccessfully that they killed the greatest part of them, and took feveral Standarts.

Lemberg, Navember 6. The King of Poland went on Thuriday last from Pomarzan to Zolkiew, where he intends to stay till towards the Meeting of the Diet, which is to be held for this time at Gredno, the Capital City of Lithuania. On the 3d instant Te Deum was Sung in the Cathedral of this City for the raising of the Siege of Sorocke on the Niester. The Tartars that made the late Incursions on the Frontiers of this Kingdom are retited again towards Budziack.

Madrid, Novemb. 12. Their Catholick Majestics returned hither on the 3d instant from the Escarial. The 6th being the King's Birth-Day, when he entred into the 32th year of his Age, was observed here with the usual Solemnity. On the 10th Don Pedro Nunez de Prado took Possession of the Office of President of the Revenues. We are told that Orders are sent to Don Pedro de Corbette General of the Fleet, which Winters at Naples, to be at Sea again early in the Spring-Frenna, Novemb. 19. The last Advices from
