WE have an account from the *Morcia*, That a Body of 6 or 7000 Turks came lately before *Lepanto*, where they opened Trenches, and made other Preparations to attack the Castle, expecting to be joined in few days by several Thousand Men more, which the Seraskier was drawing together for that design; The Garrison all this while defended themselves very well; and on the 26th of this Month made a Sally, wherein they beat the Enemy out of their Trenches, killed 4 or 500 of them, and demolished their Works: The next day the Succour that was sent them by Sea entred into the place, which so disheartned the Enemy that they broke up and retired in disorder.

Rome, *Novemb. 8.* The Count de *Rabencan*, the French Envoy, has had this Week several Conferences with the Ministers of this Court, upon the Propositions he made to the Pope at his last Audience; At the same time the Cardinals *a' Eglise* and *de Foulbin* continue their Endeavours to adjust the Matters that remain yet undetermined about the French Bishops; They both had Audience of the Pope this Week, and pressed him very earnestly to call a Consistory in order to the Preconitation of those Bishops that still want their Bulls; and he said they have obtained a promise that one shall be held for this purpose on Monday next. The Pope continues in his Resolution of making divers Reforms for advancing the Splendor and Dignity of the See of *Rome*. The Chevalier *Monaldi* General of the Popes Gallies, arrived here this Week from *Civita Vecchia*, and has given him a particular Relation of their late Expedition in the *Levant*.

Milan, *Novemb. 12.* Our Governor General the Marquis de *Leganes* is come hither, after having taken a general Review of the Forces of this State near *Novarce*, who are now dispersed into their Winter quarters. 'Tis said that his Excellency intends very suddenly to return to *Turin* to assist at a great Council of War that will be held there to prepare things for an early Campaign the next year. The Republick of *Genova* has at last agreed to pay the Contributions demanded by the Germans for Winter-Quarters.

Venice, *Novemb. 14.* The Senate has resolved to chuse a new Captain General in the place of Signior *Mocenigo*, who is made Governor of *Venezua*; but has not yet nam'd any Body for that Command. In the mean time they are taking care to reinforce their Army in the *Levant*, to which end they have not only given out Commissions this Week for raising two Regiments of Dragoons, to consist of 500 Men each, and making other new Levies in *Italy*, but are likewise treating with several Officers to raise Troops in *Germany* and *Switzerland* for the Service of the Republick. By the last Letters from *Dalmatia* we have advice, That the Morlaques have lately made several Incurions into the Enemies Territories towards *Treignes* and *Popoca*, where they plundered and burnt divers Villages, and took a considerable Booty, which they brought to *Castel-Nevo*; And that the Turks to revenge this Ravage advanced with a strong Party towards *Zurine*, with a design to spoil and destroy the Country thereabouts, but were prevented by the Morlaques, who upon notice of their march, drew together, and attackt the Enemy so successfully that they killed the greatest part of them, and took several Standarts.

Lemberg, *November 6.* The King of *Poland* went on Thursday last from *Pomargan* to *Zolkiew*, where he intends to stay till towards the Meeting of the Diet, which is to be held for this time at *Grodno*, the Capital City of *Lithuania*. On the 3d instant *Te Deum* was Sung in the Cathedral of this City for the raising of the Siege of *Sorocke* on the *Nister*. The Tartars that made the late Incurions on the Frontiers of this Kingdom are retired again towards *Budziack*.

Madrid, *Novemb. 12.* Their Catholick Majesty returned hither on the 3d instant from the *Escorial*. The 6th being the King's Birth-Day, when he entred into the 32th year of his Age, was observed here with the usual Solemnity. On the 10th Don *Pedro Nunez de Prado* took Possession of the Office of President of the Revenues. We are told that Orders are sent to Don *Pedro de Corbette* General of the Fleet, which Winters at *Naples*, to be at Sea again early in the Spring.

Vienna, *Novemb. 19.* The last Advices from *Sclavonia* say, That the Armies on both Sides are actually seperated and gone into their Winter-Quarters: And that the Grand Vister parted on the 3d instant from *Belgrade* for *Adrianople*. Prince *Lewis of Baden* is still at his Government at *Rusb*.
