approximately the average cost of maintenance of youthful offenders or children in the class of school to which such school belongs in the locality in which such school is situate.

Now, therefore, His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, being authorized thereto by writing under His Majesty's Sign Manual, and in pursuance of the above mentioned Act, doth hereby, by and with the advice of His Majesty's Privy Council, on behalf of His Majesty, declare that the sums shown in the following table represent approximately the average cost of maintenance of youthful offenders or children in the classes of schools and in the localities therein mentioned; and order that the sums which the parent or other person may be ordered to contribute under section 75 of the Children Act, 1908, shall not exceed the sums so shown:-
