NOTICE is hereby given that, pursuant to section 3 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, the Local Government Board have issued an Order declaring that on and after the 26th day of May, 1909, Part II, Part III, Part IV, and Part V of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the urban district of Annfield Plain.

And further that the section to which reference is made in the first column in the schedule hereto shall have effect until the Local Government Board, by Order, otherwise direct, as if in the case of such section the words and figures set forth in the second column of the said schedule were added to and formed part of that section.

NOTICES TO MARINERS.

(Nos. 564 to 575 of the year 1909.)

[The Astronomical positions are only approximate unless seconds are given. The bearings are Magnetic, and those relating to lights are given from seaward. The visibility of lights is that in clear weather. Fog signals are sounded only during thick or foggy weather unless otherwise stated. The depths given are at low-water ordinary springs. The heights given are above high water.]

No. 564.—BALTIC, SWEDEN—EAST COAST, KALMAR APPROACH.

*Grimskär Upper Light—Colour of Sector Altered.*

Subject.—The colour of the undermentioned sector of Grimskär Upper Light, Kalmar Sound, which has hitherto been red flashing, has been altered to that given below.

Position.—Lat. 56° 39½' N., long. 16° 22¼' E.

Colour of sector altered.—White flashing from N. 31° E. to N. 48° E.

Remarks.—In other respects the light is unaltered.

Variation.—7° W.

Charts affected.—No. 3435, Plan of Kalmar Sound Narrows; No. 2251, Kalmar Sound and Oland Island.

No. 565.—BLACK SEA—TAGANROG GULF

*Mariupol—(1) Intended Alteration in Colour of Light on North Mole Head; (2) Light-vessel to be replaced by Beacon Light; (3) Decreased Depths in Roadstead.*

Subject.—At the opening of navigation this year the following alterations in the lighting of the Port of Mariupol will take place.

1. Alteration in colour of North Mole Head Light.

Position.—Situated on the extremity of the North Mole Head; lat. 47° 3' N., long. 37° 32½' E.

Intended alteration in colour.—To be altered from white and green to green.

2. The light-vessel situated off the mouth of the River Kalmius will be replaced by a light-beacon of the undermentioned description.

Position.—Lat. 47° 4½' N., long. 37° 36' E.

Description.—Pile beacon, in 10 feet of water, surmounted by a mast and red cage exhibiting a fixed red light.

Elevation.—27 feet.
