

HUNTINGDON RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL.

BY an Order of the Local Government Board dated the 17th May, 1909, the following sections of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, will be in force in the several contributory places within the district as from the 28th day of June, 1909 (subject to the conditions and adaptations hereinafter mentioned), namely:—

Sections 15, 16, 20, 23, 25, 29, 30, 32 and 33 comprised in Part II;

Sections 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 43, 44, 45, 46 and 49 comprised in Part III; and

Sections 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65 and 66 comprised in Part IV.

The conditions and adaptations are as follows:—

Part II.

Section twenty-five. "The power of making or enforcing bye-laws under section 157 of the Public Health Act, 1875, as extended by section 23 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1890, with respect to the paving of yards and open spaces in connection with dwelling - houses shall cease to be exercisable."

Part III.

Section thirty-five. "This section, so far as it relates to the deposit of material, shall have effect subject to the first proviso to section 91 of the Public Health Act, 1875.

"Bye-laws made in pursuance of section 16 of the Local Government Act, 1888, for the prevention and suppression of nuisances shall not, in relation to any subject-matter of this section, be of any force or effect in any contributory place within the district."

Section thirty-eight. "Nothing in this section shall prejudicially affect any power or right exercisable by or attaching to any owner or occupier of premises by virtue of section 22 of the Public Health Act, 1875, or of section 18 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1890."

Part IV.

Section fifty-nine. "(6) Nothing in this section shall apply to a public or circulating library which is not within the district."

NOTICE is hereby given, that by an Order under the Seal of the Office of the Local Government Board, dated the nineteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and nine, made in pursuance of the powers conferred upon the said Board, it is declared that on and after the seventh day of July, 1909, the following portions of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the urban district of Stretford, viz.:—

Sections 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 32 and 33 comprised in Part II;
