SHEEP-SCAB (NORTH CARDIGAN-
SHIRE) ORDER OF 1909 (No. 2).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Modification of Sheep-Scab (North Cardigan-shire) Order of 1909.

1. Those provisions of the Sheep-Scab (North Cardiganshire) Order of 1909 which relate to the

dipping of all sheep in the Dipping Area between the fourteenth day of July and the first day of September in each year are hereby revoked.

2. Nothing in this Order shall affect the restrictions imposed by the aforesaid Order on the exposure of sheep for sale or exhibition in markets, fairs, saleyards, and places of exhibition in the Dipping Area, or the restrictions on the movement of sheep out of the Dipping Area.
