

Sections 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50 and 51 comprised in Part III; and

Part IV; and

Part V; of the Act of 1907, shall be in force in the several contributory places within the district.

(b) Sections 39, 40, 41 and 42 comprised in Part III of the Act of 1907, shall be in force in the contributory places of Gowerton and Llandilo Tal y Bont, within the district.

(2) Where a section to which reference is made in the first column of the schedule to the Order is a section comprised in Part IV, or Part V, or is one of the sections by sub-division (1) of this Article described as comprised in Part II or Part III, and declared to be in force, the section in any contributory place in which it is by sub-division (1) of this Article declared to be in force, shall be in force subject to the following conditions and adaptations, that is to say:—

Unless and until by a further Order, the Local Government Board otherwise declare, specify, and direct, the said section, in its application to the contributory place, and in relation to the exercise of the powers and to the discharge of the duties of the Local Authority under the section, shall have effect as if the words and figures set forth in the second column of the said schedule opposite to the reference to that section in the first column of that schedule were added to and formed part of the section.

#### PART II.

Section twenty-five. "The power of making or enforcing bye-laws under section one hundred and fifty-seven of the Public Health Act, 1875, as extended by section twenty-three of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1890, with respect to the paving of yards and open spaces in connection with dwelling-houses, shall cease to be exercisable."

Section twenty-seven. "Nothing in this section shall apply to any temporary building erected or set up for use by the Territorial Force."

#### PART III.

Section thirty-five. "This section, so far as it relates to the deposit of material, shall have effect subject to the first proviso to section ninety-one of the Public Health Act, 1875.

"Bye-laws made in pursuance of section sixteen of the Local Government Act, 1888, for the prevention and suppression of nuisances shall not, in relation to any subject-matter of this section, be of any force or effect in any contributory place within the district."

Section thirty-eight. "Nothing in this section shall prejudicially affect any power or right exercisable by or attaching to an owner or occupier of premises by virtue of section twenty-two of the Public Health Act, 1875, or of section eighteen of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1890."

#### PART IV.

Section fifty-nine. "(6) Nothing in this section shall apply to a public or circulating library which is not in any contributory place within the district."

#### PART V.

Section seventy-five. "(3) The date of the Order of the Local Government Board by which this Part is declared to be in force shall be the beginning of the period within which the local authority shall give notice for the purposes of sub-section (1) of this section."

#### NOTICES TO MARINERS.

(Nos. 1335 to 1352 of the year 1909.)

[The Astronomical positions are only approximate unless seconds are given. The bearings are Magnetic, and those relating to lights are given from seaward. The visibility of lights is that in clear weather. Fog signals are sounded only during thick or foggy weather unless otherwise stated. The depths given are at low-water ordinary springs. The heights given are above high water.]

#### No. 1335.—MEDITERRANEAN—STRAIT OF MESSINA.

##### Cape Peloro Light—Visibility; Caution.

Subject.—The undermentioned information has been received with regard to the visibility of Cape Peloro light.

Position.—Lat. 38° 15½' N., long. 15° 39½' E.

Visibility.—It is reported that the flashing white light on Cape Peloro is not visible from a distance of more than 7 miles, instead of having a visibility of 14 miles as given in a former Notice.

Caution.—As this light is only a provisional light, it must not be depended upon.

Note.—"Unreliable" has been placed against the light on the charts.
