Canada Bay and Seal Cove—Alteration in Colour of Lights.

Subject.—The characters of the undermentioned lights in White Bay have been altered as described below.

1. Canada Bay Light:

Position.—On Cape Daumalen; lat. 50° 43½' N., long. 56° 6' W.

Alteration.—Altered from a fixed white light to a fixed red light.
