

driving of a motor car at a speed not exceeding ten miles per hour shall apply and have effect within the limits comprising the road and the part of a road within the urban district of Bettwsycoed which are specified in the schedule hereto.

ARTICLE II.—These Regulations shall come into operation on the sixth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and nine.

SCHEDULE.

So much of the main road through the village of Bettwsycoed as extends from the south-eastern boundary of the old post-office to the Elsi Lake Jubilee-path; and

The road or street known as Mill-street, extending from the turning or bend under Tanybryn to its junction with the main road aforesaid.
