V. During that period of the year to which the protection afforded by the Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880 (as extended by Clause II of this Order), does not apply, the killing or taking of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the Administrative County of Hertford:—

Bittern, Tree Creeper, Crossbill, Goldfinch, Hedge Accentor (Hedge Sparrow), Water Rail, Robin, Great Grey Shrike, Lesser Grey Shrike, Woodpecker.

*All Birds protected on Sundays in certain parishes.*

VI. During that period of the year to which the protection afforded by the Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880 (as extended by Clause II of this Order), does not apply, the killing or taking of Wild Birds on Sundays is prohibited in the following parishes in the Administrative County of Hertford:—
