ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 2ND MARCH 1911.)

(SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREA.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1910, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Contraction of Limits of Swine-Fever Infected Area.

1. The limits of the Swine-Fever Infected Area extended by Order of the Board dated the thirteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and ten, are hereby contracted so as to comprise only the Area described in the Schedule to this Order, and the Area so described is hereby declared to be a Swine-Fever Infected Area for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and eleven.
