

such alteration in respect to ecclesiastical jurisdiction, glebe lands, tithes, rentcharges and other ecclesiastical dues rates and payments and in respect to patronage and rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties interested, which scheme, together with the consents thereto in writing of the Right Honourable Charles Paget Fitzhardinge Baron Fitzhardinge the patron or person entitled to present to the said benefice of Berkeley in case the same were now vacant the Reverend Henry Cranford Armour, the incumbent of the same benefice, the said Henry Cranford Armour, the patron or person entitled to present (as vicar for the time being of the said parish of Berkeley) to the said benefice of Stone in case the same were now vacant and the Reverend Thomas Veal the incumbent of the same benefice, has been transmitted to us for our consideration.

"The representation and scheme of the said Lord Bishop and the consents above referred to are hereunto annexed.

"And we the said Archbishop being on full consideration and enquiry satisfied with the said scheme do hereby pursuant to the said Pluralities Act 1838 certify the same and such consents as aforesaid to Your Majesty in Council to the intent that Your Majesty in Council may in case Your Majesty in Council shall think fit so to do make and issue an Order for carrying the said scheme into effect.
