HASTINGS ALLOTMENT GARDENS . (SWINE-FEVER) ORDER OF 1911.

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1910, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Premises to which this Order applies.

-(1.) This Order shall apply to the premises described in the Schedule hereto, and also to any other premises in the county borough of Hastings to which the Order may be applied by a Notice to that effect signed by

an Inspector of the Board or of the Local Authority of the said borough and served upon the occupier of the premises described in such Notice.

- (2.) This Order shall cease to apply to any premises upon service on the occupier thereof of a Notice to that effect signed by an Inspector of the Board.
- (3.) A copy of every Notice served under this Article shall forthwith be sent to the Board by the Inspector signing the same.

Restriction on Movement of Swine from or to Premises to which this Order applies.

2. Swine shall not, except as expressly authorised by this Order, be moved from or to any premises to which this Order applies.

Movement of Swine for Immediate Slaughter.

3.—(1.) Swine (not being in a Swine-Fever Infected Place and their movement not being prohibited by Notice of an Inspector of the Local Authority or of the Board given under any Order of the Board) may be moved from any premises to which this Order applies in a
