

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF  
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 24TH JULY 1911.)

EAST SUSSEX AND KENT (FOOT-AND-MOUTH  
DISEASE) ORDER OF 1911 (No. 2).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1910, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

PART I.

PROVISIONS AS TO SCHEDULED DISTRICT NO. I.

*Movement of Animals into, out of, or within Scheduled District No. I.*

1. No cattle, sheep, goats, or swine shall be moved into or out of the District described in the First Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as Scheduled District No. I) or be moved along, over, or across, or be allowed by the owner or person in charge thereof to stray upon, a highway or thoroughfare within that District.

*Restriction of Movement of Persons in Scheduled District No. I.*

2. Notwithstanding the existence of any footpath or right of way, no person shall enter any field, shed, or other place in Scheduled District No. I while any cattle, sheep, goats, or swine are therein, otherwise than in accordance with the following regulations, that is to say:—

(i) The owner of the field, shed, or other place, or of the animals therein, or the agent or servants of such owner, may enter such field, shed, or other place so far as may be necessary for the feeding or tending of the animals.

(ii) Any other person may enter such field, shed, or other place with a licence of an Inspector of the Local Authority or of the Board.

*Restriction of Movement of Dogs in Scheduled District No. I.*

3. No dog shall be allowed to be at large within Scheduled District No. I.

PART II.

PROVISIONS AS TO SCHEDULED DISTRICT  
NO. II.

*Movement of Animals into, out of, or within Scheduled District No. II.*

4. No cattle, sheep, goats, or swine shall be moved into or out of the District described in the Second Schedule to this Order (hereinafter

referred to as Scheduled District No. II) or be moved along, over, or across, or be allowed by the owner or person in charge thereof to stray upon, a highway or thoroughfare within that District.

PART III.

PROVISIONS AS TO SCHEDULED DISTRICT  
NO. III.

*Movement into or out of Scheduled District No. III, and Movement within such District.*

5.—(1.) No cattle, sheep, goats, or swine shall be moved into or out of the District described in the Third Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as Scheduled District No. III).

(2.) No cattle, sheep, goats, or swine shall be moved along, over, or across a highway or thoroughfare within Scheduled District No. III, except with a Movement Licence authorising such movement, granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the District in which the premises from which the animals are to be moved is situate, under and in accordance with the subsequent provisions of this Order.

(3.) A Movement Licence under this Article shall be granted by an Inspector only for the movement on a particular occasion of animals for feeding purposes, or to a slaughter-house.

(4.) A Movement Licence under this Article shall not be granted by an Inspector unless he is satisfied that the proposed movement

- (i) is necessary or expedient; and
- (ii) will not involve movement into, or out of, or along, over, or across a highway or thoroughfare within Scheduled Districts Nos. I and II; and
- (iii) will not involve movement out of Scheduled District No. III.

(5.) No cattle, sheep, goats, or swine shall be allowed by the person in charge thereof to stray upon a highway or thoroughfare within Scheduled District No. III.

*Prohibition of Markets, &c., of Animals in Scheduled District No. III.*

6. No market, fair, sale or exhibition of animals shall be held on any premises situate in Scheduled District No. III.

PART IV.

GENERAL.

*Provisions as to Movement Licences.*

7.—(1.) Where the movement authorised by a Movement Licence granted under this Order is to a slaughter-house, an animal shall not be moved with a Movement Licence unless before the movement is commenced it is marked by and at the expense of the owner in manner following:

*Cattle.*—By the clipping of a broad arrow ↑ about six inches long on the left hind quarter of each of the cattle and by the clipping of the hair off the end of the tail.
