MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903.

COUNTY OF WEST SUSSEX.

Whereas by sub-section 1 of section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, it is enacted that within any limits or place referred to in regulations made by the Local Government Board with a view to the safety of the public, on the application of the local authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour:

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of West Sussex have made application to the Local Government Board for a regulation to be made in pursuance of the said sub-section putting the above-mentioned provisions of that sub-section in force within the limits comprising the following roads within the

parish of Petworth, in the county of West Sussex, that is to say:—

The road extending from the southern extremity of Hampers Common, along North Street, Church Street, Back Road and Pound Street to a point opposite the Gas Works in Station Road, Petworth;

So much of the road from Petworth to Horsham as extends from its junction with North Street to a point opposite the Cemetery Gate;

The road extending from a point on the road from Petworth to Fittleworth at the top of Shimmings Hill, along Angel Street to its junction with East Street;

The road extending from a point in Grove Street opposite the entrance to New Grove, along Grove Street and High Street to Golden Square;
