

(2.) If any person, with a view unlawfully to evade or defeat the operation of this Order, by washing, or in any other manner, takes out, effaces, or obliterates, or attempts to take out, efface, or obliterate, any mark painted on any animal as required by this Order, the person doing the same, and the person causing, directing, or permitting the same to be done, and the owner of the animal, and the person for the time being in charge thereof, shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts and defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Act of 1894.

Interpretation.

17. In this Order—

“ The Act of 1894 ” means the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

“ The Board ” means the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries.

“ Animals ” means cattle, sheep, goats, and swine.

“ Movement ” includes landing.

“ Slaughter-house ” means any premises where animals are habitually slaughtered, and includes a bacon-factory.

Other terms have the same meaning as in the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

Revocation of Order.

18. The Somerset (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1911 (No. 2) is hereby revoked as from the commencement of this Order.

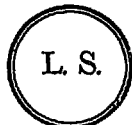
Commencement.

19. This Order shall come into operation on the eleventh day of October, nineteen hundred and eleven.

Short Title.

20. This Order may be cited as the SOMERSET (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER of 1911 (No. 3), and shall be read with the principal Order.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Zone I.

The parishes of Middlezoy and Othery.

Zone II.

The parishes of Walton, Pitney, High Ham, Huish Episcopi, Aller, and Stoke St. Gregory,

and such portion of the petty sessional division of Bridgwater as lies to the south of the Somerset and Dorset Joint Railway line running from Glastonbury to Bridgwater and to the east of the Great Western Railway line running from Bridgwater to Taunton (except the parishes of Middlezoy and Othery).

Zone III.

The petty sessional division of Bridgwater (excepting such portions thereof as are included in Zones I and II, and also excepting the parishes of Aisholt, Over Stowey, Nether Stowey, Fiddington, Stogursey, Stockland Bristol, and Otterhampton, and that part of the parish of Huntspill which lies to the west of the eastern bank of the River Parrett), and Somerton (excepting the parishes of Pitney, High Ham, Huish Episcopi, Aller, Barton St. David, Keinton Mandeville, West Lydford, East Lydford, and Babcary);

The parishes of Burnham, Burnham Without, Highbridge North, Highbridge South, Mark, Wedmore, Godney, Meare, Sharpham, Street, Butleigh, Long Load, Ash, Martock, Barrington, Stocklinch, Puckington, Isle Brewers, Isle Abbotts, Ilton, Ashill, Beer Crocombe, Curry Mallet, North Curry, Hatch Beauchamp, West Hatch, Thorn Falcon, Stoke St. Mary, St. Mary Magdalen Without, Ruish-ton, Creech St. Michael, Durston, West Monkton, Kingston (including its detached part), Cheddon Fitzpaine, and St. James Without; and

The boroughs of Bridgwater and Glastonbury.

Zone IV.

The petty sessional divisions of Crewkerne, Yeovil (except the parishes of Long Load, Ash, and Martock), Ilminster (except the parishes of Curry Mallet, Beer Crocombe, Ashill, Ilton, Isle Abbotts, Isle Brewers, Puckington, Stocklinch, and Barrington), and Bishop's Lydeard (except the parishes of Lydeard St. Lawrence and Tolland);

The parishes of Berrow, Lymppsham, Loxton, Compton Bishop, Axbridge, Cheddar, Nyland-cum-Batcombe, Chapel Allerton, Weare, Badgworth, Biddisham, East Brent, Brent Knoll, Priddy, Rodney Stoke, Westbury, Wookey, St. Cuthbert Out, Dinder, Croscombe, Shepton Mallet, Pilton, North Wootton, West Pennard, Baltonsborough, Pylle, East Pennard, West Bradley, Hornblotton, Ditcheat, Ansford, Castle Cary, Alford, Lovington, Wheathill, North Barrow, South Barrow, Sparkford, Weston Bampfylde, Barton St. David, Keinton Mandeville, West Lydford, East Lydford, Babcary, West Buckland, Bradford, Oake, Staplegrove, Norton Fitzwarren, Bishop's Hull Without, Trull, Angersleigh, Pitminster, Corfe, Orchard Portman, Thurlbear, Bickenhall, Curland, Staple Fitzpaine, Otterford, Churchstanton, Aisholt, Over Stowey, Nether Stowey, Fiddington, Stogursey, Stockland Bristol, and Otterhampton; and
