

first column of the said Schedule, such rent charges being charged upon the glebe lands, tithe rent charges and other possessions, or some of them, of the said benefices respectively: Now we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant, convey and release to the Incumbent of each such benefice and to his successors being Incumbents of the same benefice the yearly rent charge or portion of such rent charge the amount whereof is stated in the third column of the said Schedule opposite the name of such benefice to the intent that the glebe lands, tithe rent

charge and other possessions of such benefice shall, as from the twenty-ninth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and ten, be freed and absolutely released from the said yearly rent charge or portion of such rent charge, as the case may be, but in every case in which a portion only of such rent charge is so granted and released as aforesaid shall remain charged with the residue of such perpetual yearly rent charge, such residue being of the amount stated in the fourth column of the said Schedule.
