"And whereas by the authority of another Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the eleventh day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight and published in the London Gazette on the seventeenth day of the same month, part of the said parish of Silkstone was assigned as a chapelry district to the consecrated church of Saint John, situate at Dodworth, in the said parish of Silkstone, and the said chapelry district was named 'The Chapelry District of Dodworth.'

"And whereas the said district of Saint John, Barnsley, and the said chapelry district of Dodworth have become new parishes of the character contemplated by the Act of the sixth and seventh years of Her said late Majesty, chapter thirty-seven, by the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and four, and by the above mentioned Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her said late Majesty, chapter ninety-four.

"And whereas it has been represented to us, and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said new parish of Saint John, Barnsley, and of the said new parish of Dodworth should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned.

"Now therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend George Rodney, Bishop of Wakefield (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this scheme or representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme or representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said new parish of Saint John, Barnsley, and of the said new parish of Dodworth, shall be altered so that (firstly) all those portions of the said new parish of Saint John, Barnsley, which are described in the First Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such new parish and shall be restored to and shall in future form part of the said district parish of Saint George, Barnsley; (secondly) all those portions of the said district parish of Saint George, Barnsley, which are described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured yellow shall be dissevered from such district parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said new parish of Saint John, Barnsley; and (thirdly) all that portion of the said district parish of Saint George, Barnsley, which is described in the Third Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such district parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said new parish of Dodworth.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending, and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament. "The SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The FIRST SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the new parish (sometime district) of Saint John, Barnsley, in the county of York and in the diocese of Wakefield, and to be restored to the district parish of Saint George, Barnsley, in the same county and diocese, being: —All those portions of the said new parish of Saint John, Barnsley, which lie to the north and the northwest of the middle of Agnes Road and to the north-west of the middle of Hawthorne Street.

"The SECOND SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the said district parish of Saint George, Barnsley, and to be annexed to the said new parish of Saint John, Barnsley, being —All those portions of the said district parish of Saint George, Barnsley, which lie to the south of the middle of Agnes Road.

"The THIRD SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the said district parish of Saint George, Barnsley, and to be annexed to the new parish of Dodworth in the said county and diocese, being:— All that isolated portion of the said district parish of Saint George, Barnsley, which is bounded upon all sides as follows, that is to say, upon the north-east and upon the southeast by the Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Edward the Confessor, Barnsley, in the said county and diocese, and upon the south-west and upon the west by the said new parish of Dodworth."

And whereas drafts of the said scheme or representation have been transmitted to the patrons and to the Incumbents of the cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such scheme or representation, and such patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent thereto.

And whereas the said scheme or representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said scheme or representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts. And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Wakefield.
