## EGGS.

## All Eggs Protected in Certain Areas.

VI. The taking or destroying of Wild Birds' eggs is prohibited for a period of five years from the date of this Order within the following areas in the administrative county of Kent, which are coloured blue on a map deposited with the Clerk of the County Council, sealed with the Home Office seal, and dated the 12th August, 1912:-

1. So much of the Isle of Sheppey (including therein Elmley Island) as lies south of the road running from Queenborough, through Eastchurch, to Warden Point.

2. An Area bounded on the west by so much of the Sittingbourne and Sheerness Railway as lies between Kingsferry and the Sittingbourne Railway Station, and bounded on the south by the London Chatham and Dover Railway from Sittingbourne Railway Station to Whitstable Railway Station, and bounded on the east by the main road from Whitstable Station to the sea, and bounded on the north by the Swale and Whitstable Bay.
