DURHAM AND NORTHUMBERLAND (FOOT - AND - MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1912 (No. 12).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1911, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Amendment of Orders.

1. The Durham and Northumberland (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1912 (No. 9)

(hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the Durham and Northumberland (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1912 (No. 11) are modified in manner hereinafter appearing.

Prohibited Area.

2.—(1.) The Prohibited Area described in the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the Prohibited Area No. 1A (in the Chollerton District), described in the Second Schedule to the principal Order, and Part II of the principal Order shall apply to that Area accordingly.

(2.) Article 4 of the Durham and Northumberland (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1912 (No. 11) is hereby revoked.
