

2. The Area described as the Norwood (Gateshead) Prohibited Area in the Second Schedule to the principal Order.

3. An Area comprising such part of the parish of Stannington as lies within the following boundary (but excluding any roads or railways forming such boundary) namely:—

A boundary commencing at the point where the northern boundary of the parish crosses the road from Mitford to Twizell, and proceeding thence in a southerly direction along that road to its junction with the road leading to Dovecot House, thence in an easterly direction along the latter road to its junction with the road from Morpeth to Stannington, thence in a southerly direction along the last named road to its junction with the road leading to Stannington Station, thence in an easterly direction along the last named road to the point where it meets the railway line from Newcastle to Morpeth, thence along the railway line in a northerly direction to the point where the railway line crosses the parish boundary, thence in a westerly direction along the parish boundary to the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Zone I.

A Zone in the administrative county of Northumberland comprising:—

The parishes of Carrycoats, Sweethope, Deanham, South Middleton, East Shaftoe, West Shaftoe, Kirkharle, Capheaton, Harnham, Shortflatt, Bradford, Belsay, Wallridge, Kirkheaton, Kearsley, Ingoe, Black Heddon, Bitchfield, Heugh, Fenwick, West Matfen, Great Whittington, Clarewood, Aydon, East Matfen, Ouston, Hawkwell, Crookdean, Hawick, Little Harle, West Harle, Great Bavington, Little Bavington, Thockrington, Hallington, Ryal, Bingfield, Haughton (excluding its detached part), Humshaugh (excluding its detached part), Black Carts and Ryehill, Wall, Warden, Fallowfield, Acomb, Sandhoe, Cocklaw, Little Whittington, Portgate, Halton, Aydon Castle, that part of the parish of Corbridge which lies to the north of the North Eastern Railway line from Hexham to Gateshead, the parish of Chollerton (excluding such portions as lie to the north and west of the road leading from the ford at Combyheugh to Watling Street via Chipchaseclose House, Black Hill, Pit House, Sooty Row, and Middle Cowden, and to the west of Watling Street), and such part of the parish of Birtley as lies between the road above referred to and the Chollerton parish boundary.

(The Prohibited Area No. 1a is excluded from this Zone.)



Contraction of Limits of Swine-Fever Infected Area.
