

of overdraft or otherwise, on the security of any funds, rates or revenues or property of the Corporation for the purpose of defraying current expenses in connection with the carrying out or execution of any duties or powers imposed or conferred on them by any Act of Parliament, Provisional Order, or otherwise, and to utilise temporarily any reserve fund or sinking fund belonging to them for the purposes of any such expenses.

20. To authorize the Corporation to borrow money for the purchase of the Company's undertaking or in connection therewith, for the proposed street works and improvements, and for the payment of costs, charges, interest and other sums payable by the Corporation in connection with the determination of the purchase price and the transfer of the undertaking, and also for the general purposes of the electrical undertaking of the Corporation, and to charge the money so to be borrowed and the interest thereon upon the undertakings, rates, revenues, and other property of the Corporation or any of them, and to execute and grant mortgages, debentures, debenture stock, and annuities in respect thereof.

21. To make provision in regard to the application of the revenue of the undertaking and to empower the Corporation to apply the same to the extension or improvement of the works or for other purposes of their undertaking or to carry the same to the relief of the rates of the borough, and to make provision for meeting any deficiency in such revenue out of the rates of the borough and for the formation and application of depreciation and other funds and to make further provision with reference to the finances of the Corporation.

22. To confer upon the Corporation and the Company all rights, powers, authorities and privileges which are or may become necessary or desirable for carrying into effect the objects and purposes of the intended Act, and to vary and extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might in any manner impede or interfere with any such objects or purposes, and to confer other exemptions, rights and privileges.

23. To alter, amend or repeal all or some of the provisions of the Hove Corporation Act, 1912, the said Orders, and of any other local Act of Parliament or Order confirmed by Act of Parliament relating to the borough and the Hove Commissioners Act, 1873.

24. To incorporate, with or without amendment, or to render applicable all or some of the provisions of the following public Acts:—The Public Health Acts, the Local Government Acts, the Local Loans Act, 1875, the Lands Clauses Acts, and the Electric Lighting Acts, 1882 to 1909.

HERNE BAY GAS AND ELECTRICITY.

(Transfer from the Herne Bay Urban District Council to the Herne Bay Gas and Coke Company Limited of the Powers of the Herne Bay Electric Lighting Order, 1909; Supply of Electricity by Company; Generating Station; Breaking Up of Public and Private Streets; Rates and Charges; Accounts; Dividends; Additional Capital; Repeal and Incorporation of Acts.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the Herne Bay Gas and Coke Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") for an Act for all or some of the following objects and purposes (that is to say):—

1. To make provision for the transfer from the Herne Bay Urban District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") to the Company of the undertaking authorized by the Herne Bay Electric Lighting Order, 1909, which was confirmed by the Electric Lighting Orders Confirmation (No. 1) Act, 1909, and is hereinafter referred to as "the Order," together with all or some of the rights, powers, duties and obligations under the Order or the enactments incorporated therewith upon and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in the intended Act or as may be agreed between the Council and the Company.

2. To empower the Council and the Company to enter into and carry into effect agreements in regard to any of the matters mentioned in this notice, the supply of electricity for any purposes for which the Council may require electricity, the ultimate purchase of the undertaking by the Council and other matters, and to confirm and give effect to all agreements entered into between them before the passing of the intended Act.

3. To incorporate with the Bill and generally to make applicable to the area of supply such of the provisions contained in the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as are applicable to cases in which the undertakers are a company, and to apply such provisions to the undertaking to be authorized by the Bill, subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.

4. To authorize the Company to produce, store, supply, sell and distribute electrical energy for public and private purposes within the urban district of Herne Bay, in the county of Kent (hereinafter called "the area of supply").

5. To empower the Company on the lands hereinafter described or on any part thereof to erect, maintain, work and use a station or
