PONTYPRIDD AND RHONDDA JOINT WATER BOARD.

(Confirmation of Agreement with Merthyr Tydfil Corporation for Supply to Board of Water in Bulk; Construction of Waterworks; Deviation; Breaking up of Streets, &c.; Compulsory Purchase of Lands and Easements for Works; Additional Lands; Modification of Lands Clauses Acts with respect to Superfluous Lands, Compensation

and Payment of Costs; Extension of Time for Acquisition of Lands and Making Works; Revival of Powers and Amendment of Section 50 (For the Protection of Viscount Tredegar) of the Pontypridd and Rhondda Water Act, 1910; Amendment of Section 59 of that Act Relative to Supply of Water by the Board to Llantrisant and Llantwit Fardre Rural District Council; Increase of Rates and Charges; Application of Money; Borrowing Powers for Works and for Costs of Opposition; Miscellaneous and Incidental Provisions; Incorporation, Amendment and Repeal of Acts.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the Pontypridd and Rhondda Joint Water Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") for an Act for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To sanction, confirm, or give effect to, with or without modification and alteration, an agreement, dated the 3rd day of July, 1912, and made between the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the county borough of Merthyr Tydfil (hereinafter called "the Corporation") of the one part and the Board of the other part with reference to the supply of water in bulk by the Corporation to the Board under which agreement it is provided (inter alia) (a) that the supply of water to be given by the Corporation to the Board shall take priority over any supply which the Corporation may give beyond the statutory limits of the Corporation for the supply of water other than the supplies of water to be given by the Corporation to the Rhymney and Aber Valleys Gas and Water Company and the Urban District Council of Barry under the agreements in that behalf set forth in the third schedule to the Merthyr Tydfil Corporation Water Act, 1911, and other than the supply of water to be given by the Corporation to the Urban District Council of Caerphilly under section 49 of the said Act; (b) that in certain events the Corporation shall discontinue to supply water under any agreement which they may have made after the 3rd day of July, 1912, for the supply of water in bulk beyond their statutory limits of supply and that the right of any person to take any such supply shall thereupon cease; and (c) that any agreement made after the 3rd day of July, 1912, by the Corporation for the supply of water in bulk beyond their statutory limits of supply shall be subject to the foregoing and other provisions of the agreement proposed to be sanctioned and confirmed by the Bill.

To sanction, confirm or give effect to any further agreement between the Corporation and the Board with respect to the matters aforesaid or any of them.

To empower the Board to construct and maintain in the county of Glamorgan the following works or some part or parts thereof (that is to say):—

Work No. 1.—An aqueduct, conduit or one or more line or lines of pipes, commencing by a junction with the aqueduct Work No. 18, authorized by the Pontypridd Waterworks and Tramroad Act, 1908, in the public road between Quaker's-yard and Pontypridd at a point distant 187 yards or thereabouts measured in a straight line in a south-westerly direction from the point at which the boundary of the county borough
