The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice, in pursuance of Clause 9 of the Order in Council of the 10th January, 1910, that, with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, they have prescribed that persons holding established situations in Public Departments, who are presented for Certificates of Qualification under the Order in Council of 10th January, 1910, on being transferred to another Department, shall be exempt from the payment of a fee in respect of the issue of such Certificates of Qualification, unless they are required to undergo further literary examination.

This notice supersedes paragraph (3) of the notice respecting fees published in the London Gazette of the 19th April, 1901.

The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that an Open Competitive Examination of Candidates for registration as Temporary Boy Clerks will be held in London, Edinburgh, Dublin, Birmingham, Bristol, Cardiff, Leeds, Liverpool, Newcastle-on-Tyne, Plymouth, Southampton, Glasgow, Belfast, and Cork, commencing on the 8th April, 1913, under the Regulations dated the 13th December, 1912, and published in the London Gazette of the same date.

The number to be registered will depend partly on the requirements of the service, and partly on the number of Candidates who may show sufficient proficiency; but it is not likely to be less than 250, if so many shall be found competent: that is to say, 230 for service in

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
