testimony whereof he hath to this scheme set his hand and his episcopal seal), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that, as from the day on which any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme shall be published in the London Gazette, and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, each of the said Archdeaconries of Halifax and Huddersfield shall comprise and consist of those rural deaneries, the names of which are set down in order under its name, and are numbered consecutively in the schedule to this scheme annexed, and that the name which in such schedule is given to any rural deanery shall be the name thereof, and that every parish, or cure, or church, the name of which is set down in numbered order under the name

of any rural deanery in the first column of the said schedule, shall belong to, and be a part of, the rural deanery and of the archdeaconry under the name of which it so appears, as aforesaid, and shall be subject to the jurisdiction and authority of the rural dean and archdeacon thereof, and shall not any longer belong to, or be a part of, any other rural deanery or of any other archdeaconry, or be subject to the jurisdiction or authority of any other rural dean or of any other archdeacon.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other matter, or thing, with respect to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, under or by virtue of the said Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.
