Notes, May 8. The 24th of this month is fixt for the Doge-D parture to the Levant; and 'is refolved that the whole Senate shall accompany him to the Lide, where he is to Embark; which will be performed with great Solemnity. 'Tis believed that the Count de Trautsmandorf, who is now Lieutenant General of the Land Forces of this Scate, will be made General of the same, and that Signious Francisco seeingo will she ced him in the Command of Lieutenant General. Then, May 9. Yesterday the Duke of Savoy went from hence to Chiert, where he intends to stay some time; His Royal Highness is resolved, in case his Health will permit it, to make the Campague again in Person: The Troops of the Milancze, together with the Germans that have Wintered in the Duches of Mantus, Parma, and Modens, will now in rew days begin their march this way: The highest Troops are moving from Daugh ne towards Sula, between which place and Pignerol they task of forming a Comp. They are now at Work upon thee Redourss over against Vilan, la Perouse, and Dibson, on their side the River Gasson, to secure their Conveys, and hinder the locurious of the Vaudois, who are very troubsessme to them.

Warfaw, April 27. The last Advices from the Frontiers inform us, That the Moldavians are preparing, with the Assistance of the Turks and Tartars to make a second attempt upon the Fortreis of Norocke on the Niester, upon which Orders are given to reinforce that Garison, and to furnish them with a fresh supply of Provisions and Ammunition. The Imperial Ambassador has lately had several Conferences with the Chief Ministers of this Court about the present juncture of Affairs; and as we are assured they have given him Assurances not only of the King of Poland's firm Resolution to reject all Overtures that may be made him for a separate Peace, but that he will employ his whole force in the profecution of the War. They write from Lemberg, That they were informed by fome Prifoners, taken by a Party of Poles, who had made an Incursion towards the Frontiers of Moldavia, that the Cham of Tartary had received a new Summons, accompanied with large Presents from the Port, to send the greatest part of his Troops to joyn the

Ottoman Army in Hungary.

Cologne, May 19. From the Upper Rhine we have an account, That the Imperial and Bavarian Troops, with those of the Circles of Francoina and Suabia, held their General Rendezvous on the 19th instant at Great Guttach, between Hnibron and Hyd-theigh; And from Coblenze they write, That the Imperialitis; Neuburgers, Hessiens, and Munitariene, in Garilon there, had Orders to march to N. ckar-Um, to joyn the Forces of the El et rof Sakviig and the Landersup of Helle, who are to Rendezvous pear to N. ckar-Uim, to joyn the Forces of the El et rof Sakeny and the Landtgrave of Heffe, who are to Rendezvousnear that place. The French Troops continue to march from Asace, Burgundy, and Lorraine, to their Camp near Landau; and we are told, that their heavy Artillery is sent by Water from Strasbourg to Philippburg. The last Letters from Freysingen, where the Elector of Cologne, has at present his Rendence, toll us, That his Electoral Highness has at last declared himself in favour of the Ninth Electorate. There have of late passed through this place towards Nimeguen several Companies of Sussiers and Grisons, who have been raised for the Service of Holland.

Paris, Asar 18. The Troops of the Houskeld marched the last Week towards Fiangers; and this day the French King went to Chantill, where he will stay 2 or 3 days, and then continue his Journey towards Perome and Valentiennes. The Letters from Piedmont continue to say, That the Confederate Troops on that side are resolved to entergain into Dauphine, and that in order thereunto they
