

(2) Copies of such Notice shall be affixed or exhibited by the Inspector in such manner as he shall think desirable for ensuring notification of the restrictions hereby imposed.

(3) A copy of every such Notice shall forthwith be sent by the Inspector to the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, 4, Whitehall-place, London, S.W.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

3. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Offences.

4.—(1) If an animal is landed in contravention of this Order, the owner and the charterer and the master of the vessel from which it is landed, and the owner of the animal and the person for the time being in charge thereof, and the person causing, directing or permitting the landing, and the person landing the same, and the consignee or other person receiving or keeping it, knowing it to have been landed in contravention as aforesaid, shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts and defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

(2) If an animal is moved in contravention of this Order, the owner of the animal, and the person for the time being in charge thereof, and the person causing, directing, or permitting the movement, and the person moving or conveying the animal, and the consignee or other person receiving or keeping it, knowing it to have been moved in contravention as aforesaid, and the occupier of the place from which the animal is moved shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts and defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Disease of Animals Act, 1894.

(3) If any person enters any field, shed, or other place in contravention of this Order, or of a Notice served thereunder, such person shall be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

Short Title.

5. This Order may be cited as the EAST SUSSEX (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1913.

SCHEDULE.

Scheduled District.

A District comprising, in the administrative county of East Sussex:—

The petty sessional divisions of Hailsham and Battle (except the parish of *Ewhurst*); the petty sessional division of Hastings (including the borough of *Beaxhill* and the Liberty of the *Sluice Cinque Port Liberty of Hastings* and the other detached part of the petty sessional division of Hastings, but excluding the parishes of *Guestling*, *Pett*, and *Fairlight*); such part of the petty sessional division of *Uckfield* as lies to the south and east of the London, Brighton and South Coast Railway line, via *Uckfield*; and the parishes of *May-*

field, *Burwash*, *Seaford*, *East Blatchington*, *Bishopstone*, *Denton*, *Denton Urban*, *Newhaven*, *Piddinghoe*, *Telscombe*, *Southeast*, *Beddingham* (including its detached part), *Tarring Neville*, *South Heighton*, *Alciston* (including its detached part), *Berwick*, *Selmeston* (including its detached parts), *West Firle*, *Glynde*, *Ringmer*, *South Malling Without*, *Rodmell*, *Iford* (including its detached part), *Southover Without*, *Kingston near Lewes* and *St. Ann Without*, and the detached part of the parish of *St. John Without*; and the borough of *Lewes*; and also comprising the county boroughs of *Eastbourne* and *Hastings*.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 13TH NOVEMBER 1913.)

(SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREA.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1911, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Declaration of Swine-Fever Infected Area.

1. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Swine-Fever Infected Area for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the eighteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirteen.
