

late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Saint Peter, Devizes, in the county of Wilts, and in the diocese of Salisbury, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, one yearly sum or stipend of twenty-five pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient in our opinion to produce the said yearly sum or stipend, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said vicarage of Saint Peter, Devizes, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter forty-one ("The Parish of Manchester Division Act, 1850") of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven and of the Act of the thirty-first and thirty-second years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and fourteen ("The Ecclesiastical Commission Act, 1868"), do, out of the moneys which have been paid over to us by the Dean and Canons of the Cathedral Church in Manchester, under the provisions of the hereinbefore first-mentioned Act, hereby grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the district of Saint Andrew, Droylsden, situate within the original limits of the parish of Manchester, in the county of Lancaster, and in the diocese of Manchester, a payment at the rate of two hundred and fifty pounds per annum for the period commencing the fourteenth day of October, in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and terminating the first day of May, in the year one thousand nine hundred and fourteen.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction consisting of two pieces of land, comprising together one rood or thereabouts, which have been permanently secured by deed dated the twenty-ninth day of September in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, as

additions to the site of the parsonage or house of residence of the vicarage of Farnham, in the county of York, and in the diocese of Ripon, and in consideration also of a further benefaction consisting of a piece of land comprising one hundred and fifty-three square yards or thereabouts, which has been permanently secured by deed bearing the same date as an addition to the endowments of the said vicarage, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Farnham, to meet the aforesaid benefactions, one capital sum of two hundred and two pounds, to be applicable so far as may be necessary towards defraying the cost of improving the parsonage or house of residence of the said vicarage, according to plans and a specification approved or to be approved by us, such capital sum, or the balance thereof unapplied to such purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands at interest after the rate of two pounds and ten shillings per centum per annum, and such interest to be paid to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Farnham.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the vicarage of Christ Church, North End, Finchley, in the county of Middlesex and in the diocese of London, one yearly sum or stipend of sixty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the first day of February in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and to be receivable in four equal portions, on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year. Provided always that the annual sum or stipend so granted by us to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of Christ Church, North End, Finchley, shall be paid only upon the production to us on or after each of the said lastly-mentioned days in each and every year of a certificate under the hand of the Bishop of the said diocese of London that two assistant curates, duly licensed by such bishop, have been employed within the parish of Christ Church, North End, Finchley aforesaid, during the quarter of the year then ended. Provided also that such yearly sum or stipend shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the said vicarage and parish of Christ Church, North End, Finchley.
