Issue of Certificate under Children Act, 1908.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department, on the application of the Managers of the Church Army Home at Queen Elizabeth's Lodge, Old Southgate, London, N., has certified that the said Home is fit to be a Reformatory School for the reception of such girls as may be sent thereto in pursuance of the provisions of the Children Act, 1908.

The certificate, which bears date the 18th February, 1914, provides that the number of inmates resident in the Home at any one time, whether sent thereto in pursuance of the said provisions or not, shall not exceed twenty-five.
