ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 5TH MARCH 1914.)

SMALL HOLDINGS AND ALLOTMENTS ACT, 1908.

Whereas the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries considered a report made to them in pursuance of section 3 of the Small Holdings and Allotments Act, 1908, by Mr. Arthur Allsebrook, a Small Holdings Commissioner acting under their directions, with respect to the provision of land to meet the demand for small holdings ascertained to exist at Banks in the parish of North Meols, in the administrative county of Lancaster, and such report was forwarded by the said Board to the Council of the said county;

And whereas the said Council declined to undertake the duty of preparing one or more draft Schemes to give effect to the said report and the said Board thereupon directed Mr. Arthur Allsebrook, one of the Small Holdings Commissioners, to prepare one or more such draft Schemes;

And whereas a copy of a draft Scheme prepared in accordance with such direction was sent to the said Board and to the said Council, and the said draft Scheme, after being published and advertised and in all other respects

dealt with as required by the said Act, was settled and confirmed by the said Board;

And whereas the said Council have failed to fulfil the obligations imposed on them by the said Scheme within such time as is therein specified;

Now the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-section two of section six of the said Act, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby direct the Small Holdings Commissioners to take such steps as may be necessary for carrying the said Scheme into effect.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 6TH MARCH 1914.)

(WART DISEASE OF POTATOES INFECTED AREA.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Destructive Insects and Pests Acts, 1877 and 1907, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

Declaration of Wart Disease of Potatoes Infected Area.

1. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be infected with Wart Disease, and an Infected Area for the purposes of the Wart Disease of Potatoes (Infected Areas) Order of 1914.

Notification of Disease.

2. Reports of the existence of Wart Disease within the Infected Area shall be made to the Board or to the Clerk to the Urban District Council, Council Offices, Bowdon, Altrincham.

Commencement.
