Parishes of the character contemplated by the Act of the sixth and seventh years of Her said late Majesty, chapter thirty-seven, by the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and four, and by the above mentioned Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her said late Majesty, chapter ninety-four.

"And whereas it has been represented to us, and it appears to us to be expedient, that the boundaries of the said New Parish of Hope and of the said New Parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Tunstall, should be altered in the

manner which is hereinafter mentioned.
"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend John Augustine, Bishop of Lichfield (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), We, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend, and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation, and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, the boundaries of the said New Parish of Hope and of the said New Parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Tunstall, shall be altered so that (firstly) all that portion of the said District Parish of Shelton which is described in the First Schedule hereunder written, and is delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed, and is thereon coloured pink, shall be dissevered from such District Parish, and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Hope; and (secondly) all that portion of the said District Parish of Christ Church, Tunstall, which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written, and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed, and is thereon coloured green, shall be dissevered from such District Parish, and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Tunstall.

"And we further represent, recommend, and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending, and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or any of them, or any

other Act of Parliament.

"The Schedules to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference:

"THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the District Parish of Shelton, in the county of Stafford and in the Diocese of Lichfield, and to be annexed to the New Parish of Hope, in the

same county and diocese, being:
"All that portion of the said District Parish of Shelton which is bounded upon the east and upon the north by the said New Parish of Hope, upon the west by the New Parish of Etruria, in the said county and diocese, and upon the remaining side—that is to say, upon the south-by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Etruria from the said District Parish of Shelton (which follows the old course of Boothen Brook) crosses the middle of the Potteries Loop Line of the North Staffordshire Railway, and, extending thence eastward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of eight chains and a half or thereabouts, to the centre of the bridge which carries such line of railway across the line of railway belonging to the Shelton Iron, Steel, and Coal Company Limited, and extending thence first south-eastward and then north-eastward along the middle of the last-mentioned line of railway for a distance of fourteen chains and a half or thereabouts to its terminus, and extending thence in a straight line due east for a distance of two chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of Cloughstreet, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Clough-street for a distance of nine chains or thereabouts to its junction with Marsh-street, and extending thence northward along the middle of Marsh-street for a distance of fifteen yards or thereabouts to its junction with Brunswick-street upon the boundary which divides the said District Parish of Shelton from the said New Parish of Hope.

"THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the District Parish of Christ Church, Tunstall, in the said county and diocese, and to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Tunstall, in the same county and diocese, being:-

"All that portion of the said District Parish of Christ Church, Tunstall, which is bounded upon the south-west and upon the south-east by the said New Parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Tunstall, and upon the remaining sides—that is to say, upon the east, upon the north-east, and upon the north-by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Tunstall, from the said District Parish of Christ Church, Tunstall, at the junction of John-street with High-street, and extending thence northward along the middle of High-street for a distance of five chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road running along the southern side of Market-square, and extending thence first south-westward along the middle of such road and then north-westward along the middle of the road running along the western side of the said square for a distance in all of six chains and a half or thereabouts to the junction of the last-mentioned road with Paradise-street, and extending thence south-westward along the middle of Paradise-street for a distance of one chain and three-quarters or thereabouts to its junction with Cross-street, and extending thence first north-westward, then northward, and then again north-west-ward, along the middle of Cross-street (thereby crossing Wellington-street) for a distance of seven chains and a quarter or thereabouts to its junction with Well-street, and extending thence westward along the middle of Well-street for a distance of four chains or thereabouts to its junction with Sneyd-street upon the boundary which divides the said District Parish of Christ Church, Tunstall, from the said New Parish of Saint Mary the Virgin,

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme or Representation have been transmitted to the patrons and to the Incumbents of the cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such Scheme or Representation, and such patrons and Incumbents have respecttively signified their assent thereto.
