

where the swine are accompanied during the movement by a Declaration (Form E.) in the form set forth in the First Schedule to the Swine Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908, or to the like effect, signed by the owner of the swine, or his agent authorised in writing for the purpose, but except for this substitution of a declaration for a licence the conditions affecting the movement shall not be hereby varied.

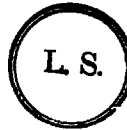

1. The limits of the Swine-Fever Infected Area declared by Order of the Board dated

the twenty-seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and fourteen, are hereby contracted so as to comprise only the Area described in the Schedule to this Order, and the Area so described is hereby declared to be a Swine-Fever Infected Area for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908.
