NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT, 1911.

(1 & 2 Geo. V., Ch. 55.)

Notice is hereby given, under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Insurance Commissioners, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 46 (7) of the National Insurance Act, 1911, as amended by the National Insurance (Navy and Army) Act, 1914, to make regulations with respect to soldiers specially enlisted for the purposes of the present war, and to persons who, being previously insured, serve during the present war as commissioned or warrant officers of the Naval Reserves, or officers of the Reserve or of the Territorial Force, or are granted temporary commissions in the regular forces during the continuance of the present war.

NEWTON-IN-MAKERFIELD.

Whereas the Urban District Council of the Urban District of Newton-in-Makerfield have made application to the Local Government Board for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, to partially repeal, alter, or amend the Newton District Improvement Act, 1855, as altered by certain Provisional Orders made by the Local Government Board, and duly confirmed by Parliament, so as

(1) To enable the Council to use for the manufacture and storage of gas and residual products a piece of land situate at Earlestown in the District, having an area of 9,600 square yards or thereabouts, and bounded on the east and north-east partly by Wargrave Old Road and partly by land belonging to the devisees of Robert Houghton, deceased, on the west and north-west by the London and North-Western Railway (Earlestown to Warrington branch), and on the south by land belonging to Lord Newton; and

(2) To authorise the Council to borrow, with the sanction of the Local Government Board, such sums as may from time to time be required for the purposes of the gas undertaking of the Council.

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application, and that it should make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said District as may be necessary or desirable for the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with incidental to, or consequent on those purposes:

Notice is hereby given, that F. O. Stanford, Esquire, A.M.Inst.C.E., one of the Inspectors of the said Board, will attend at the Town Hall, Earlestown, on Friday, the twenty-third day of October, 1914, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given, that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.
