FOREIGN HAY AND STRAW (AMEND-
MENT) ORDER OF 1914 (No. 5).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Prohibition of Landing of Hay and Straw from Sweden.

1. Hay and straw brought from Sweden shall be subject to the prohibition of landing contained in the Foreign Hay and Straw Order of 1912, and the Foreign Hay and Straw (Amendment) Order of 1912 shall cease to operate accordingly.

Short Title.

2. This Order may be cited as the FOREIGN HAY AND STRAW (AMENDMENT) ORDER OF 1914 (No. 5).
