PART X.

Section 93.—Provision of life - saving appliances.

By Article II (1) of the said Order it is also declared that on and after the date of the confirmation of any byelaws made by the local authority under the Public Health Acts, 1875 to 1907, with respect to the height of buildings, section 40 of the Bootle Corporation Act, 1890, shall be no longer in force in the said borough.

By Article II (2) of the said Order it is also declared that on and after the said 20th day of February, 1915, the date when the said Order comes into operation, section 38, subsection (1) of section 41, sections 68, 88 and 95 of the Bootle Corporation Act, 1890, and section 19 (so far as the section relates to any

subject-matter of section 23 of the Act of 1907), section 37, and section 43 (so far as the section relates to any subject-matter of section 65 of the Act of 1907) of the Bootle Corporation Act, 1899, shall be no longer in force in the said borough.

And by Article III of the said Order it is directed that a statement of the effect of the said Order shall be published in the London Gazette within the period of three weeks immediately following the said 2nd day of January, 1915.
