THE ROLL OF THE BARONETS.

THE first issue of the Roll of the Baronetage took place on the 21st February, 1914, giving a complete List of the Baronetcies of England, Scotland, Ireland, Great Britain and the United Kingdom up to the 1st December, 1913. The present issue of the Roll gives a List of these Baronetcies up to the 4th December, 1914.

It is believed that the issue of the Roll has had the effect, in some cases, of preventing the assumption of the title Baronet by persons who have no right thereto, and has provided a means of easily detecting spurious claims to the Dignity. The Roll is easily accessible and has been placed on sale at a cost of one shilling and sixpence.
