

late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 50, and of the Act of the 23rd and 24th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 124, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme, bearing date the 14th day of January, in the year 1915, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“ We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 16th and 17th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 50, and of the Act of the 23rd and 24th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 124, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for effecting an exchange of the Patronage of the Benefice (being a Rectory) of Clannaborough, situate in the County of Devon, and in the Diocese of Exeter, for the Patronage of the Benefice (being a Rectory) of Beaworthy, situate in the same County and Diocese.

“ Whereas the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Clannaborough is vested in Your Majesty, Your Heirs, and Successors, and is exercised on behalf of Your Majesty by the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being.

“ And whereas the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Beaworthy is vested in the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Exeter (hereinafter called ‘ The said Dean and Chapter of Exeter ’).

“ And whereas the Right Honourable Richard Burdon, Viscount Haldane, now Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and the said Dean and Chapter of Exeter have respectively signified to us their desire that the patronage of the said two Benefices of Clannaborough and Beaworthy may be rearranged by way of exchange in the manner which is hereinafter recommended and proposed.

“ And whereas we have made due inquiry and calculation as to the circumstances and relative value of the said two Benefices and of the Patronage thereof respectively, and we do hereby certify to Your Majesty in Council that the circumstances and present values of

the said two Benefices are as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed.

“ And whereas the yearly value of the said Benefice of Clannaborough in Your Majesty's books is £5 17s. 3½d. and the yearly value of the said Benefice of Beaworthy in the same books is £6 6s.

“ Now, therefore, with the consent of the said Richard Burdon, Viscount Haldane, (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme), and with the consent of the said Dean and Chapter of Exeter, (in testimony whereof they have caused their Common or Capitular Seal to be affixed to this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme, and without any conveyance or assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, the whole Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Clannaborough, and the Church thereof, shall be assigned and transferred from Your Majesty, Your Heirs, and Successors, and shall become and be absolutely vested in, and shall and may from time to time, and at all times, be exercised by the said Dean and Chapter of Exeter for ever, and that in exchange for the same the whole Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Beaworthy, and the Church thereof, shall in like manner and upon and from the same date be assigned and transferred from the said Dean and Chapter of Exeter, and shall become and be absolutely vested in Your Majesty, Your Heirs, and Successors for ever, and shall and may from time to time, and at all times, be exercised by the said Richard Burdon, Viscount Haldane, or other the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being.

“ And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of either of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.
