WILD BIRD (ENGLAND).

The Wild Birds Protection (Administrative County of Kent) Order, 1915.

Dated 11th February, 1915.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1908, and upon application by the Council of the administrative county of Kent, I hereby make the following order:—

Title.

I. This Order may be cited as "The Wild Birds Protection (Administrative County of Kent) Order, 1915."

BIRDS.

Extension of Close Time throughout the County.

II. The time during which the killing or taking of Wild Birds is prohibited by the Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall, except as regards the Common Wild Duck, be extended throughout the administrative county of Kent, so as to be between the last day of February and the 2nd day of September in each year.

Additions to the Schedule of the Act of 1880.

III. The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall apply to the following species of Wild Birds in the same manner as if those species were included in the Schedule to the Act:---
