Requiring the Attendance of the Members
of both Houses of Parliament.

MARIE R. E being desirous that the Members of both Haufes may have convenient No. tice of the time when their Attendance in Parliament will be requisite, 10 the end they may order their Affairs so as that there may then be a full Affirmily, Have (with the Advice of Our Privy Council) thought fit to Issue this Our Royal Proclamation; hereby Declaring and Publishing Our Will and Pleasure, That Our Parliament shall on the Third Day of October next (to which Day the same is now Prorogued) be further Prorogued unto Thursday the Six and Twentieth Day of October next. In Order to which Prorogation We shall Expect the Attendance only of such Members as shall be Resident in or near Our Cities of London and Westminster. And Our Purpose being that Our said Houses of Parliament shall not only Meet upon the said Six and Twentieth Day of October next, but shall Sit for the Dispatch of divers weighty and important Affairs, We do therefore hereby Charge and Require all the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens and Burgesses of the House of Commons to give their Attendance at Westminster on the Six and Twentie: b Day of October next accordingly.
