## UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (COURTS OF REFEREES) EMERGENCY REGULATIONS, 1915.

The Board of Trade, in pursuance of Section 91 of the National Insurance Act, 1911, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Courts of Referees) Emergency Regulations, 1915, and shall come into force on the date hereof.

2. Notwithstanding the limitation prescribed by Regulation 20 (iv.) of the Unemployment Insurance Regulations, 1912, the term of office of the members of the first panels of Courts of Referees constituted under Part

II. of the National Insurance Act, 1911, shall continue for the duration of the present war and such period not exceeding one year thereafter as the Board of Trade may direct.
