by Order in Council: "And whereas we consider that the extra work and responsibility devolving upon the Head of the Coding Staff in the larger Ships of

Your Majesty's Fleet deserve recognition: "We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased, by Your Order in Council, to sanction the payment as from the 14th day of April, 1915, during the period of hostilities, of an allowance of 1s. a day to Officers acting as Head of the Coding Staff on board Ships allowed a Captain in command, or the alternative ranks of Captain or Commander in command, whether actually commanded by a Captain or Com-mander, such allowance, however, not to be paid to Secretaries, Secretaries' Clerks, or

Officers specially appointed for Coding Duties. "The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their con-currence in this proposal."
