Lieutenant Guy D'Oyly-Hughes, D.S.C., R.N.

For his services on the 21st August, 1915, when he voluntarily swam to the shore alone from a submarine, and blew up a low brick-work support to the Ismid railway line, in spite of the presence of an armed guard within 150 yards of him. After a running fight of about a mile, he dived into the sea, and was finally pulled on board the submarine utterly exhausted, having had to swim nearly a mile in his clothes.
