

feeding or watering the animals within the railway station premises where such untrucking takes place.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

3. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Offences.

4. If an animal is moved in contravention of this Order the owner of the animal, and the person for the time being in charge thereof, and the person causing, directing, or permitting the movement, and the person moving or conveying the animal, and the consignee or other person receiving or keeping it, knowing it to have been moved in contravention as aforesaid, and the occupier of the place from which the animal is moved shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts and defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

Commencement.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and fifteen.

Short Title.

6. This Order may be cited as the PEMBROKESHIRE (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1915 (No. 4).

SCHEDULE.

Area referred to in this Order.

An Area comprising such portion of the parish of Angle, in the administrative county of Pembroke, as lies to the north and west of a boundary line commencing at a point in the eastern boundary of the parish where it is crossed by the high-water mark of Angle Bay, and proceeding in a westerly direction along the high-water mark to the western side of the road leading from the Boat House (via Coombs) to Jeffersonwalls, thence in a southerly direction along the western side of that road to its junction with the road leading from Kilpaison Burrows to Cartersgreen, thence in a westerly direction along the northern side of that road for a distance of about 80 feet to a point opposite a fence running due south from the southern side of that road to the high-water mark in the Bristol Channel, thence in a southerly direction across the road and along that fence to the high-water mark.

SOMERSET AND DISTRICT (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1915 (No. 5).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Modification of Order.

1. The Somerset and District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1915 and the Somerset and District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1915 (No. 4), hereinafter referred to as Order (No. 1) and Order (No. 4) respectively, are modified in manner hereinafter appearing.

Continued Prohibition of Movement in certain Prohibited Areas.

2. The prohibition of movement of animals contained in Order (No. 1) shall apply without modification to the Areas described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as Prohibited Areas).

Movement within Zone I, and into Zone I for Immediate Slaughter.

3.—(1.) The provisions of Order (No. 4) applicable to the Zone described in the First Schedule thereto shall cease to apply to that Zone, and shall apply to the Zone I described in the Schedule hereto.

(2.) For the purpose of movement into Zone I for immediate slaughter, Zone II shall be treated as if it were not in the Scheduled District.

Free Movement into and within Zone II; Movement out of Zone II for slaughter only.

4.—(1.) The prohibition of movement of animals contained in the Order (No. 1) shall not apply to any movement of animals—

(a) within Zone II described in the Schedule hereto;

(b) into Zone II from premises situate outside the Scheduled District; or

(c) out of Zone II to a slaughterhouse, provided that in any case in which the place of destination is in Zone I the movement shall be in accordance with Article 2 of Order (No. 4), and that in any case in which the place of destination is outside the Scheduled District, the animal shall be accompanied by a movement Licence, authorizing such movement, granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the District in which the premises from which the animal is to be moved are situate, and shall be marked before the movement is commenced, by and
